photography again and have been enjoying it ever since. I have been lucky enough to take advantage of yet another upgrade by my brother, and being able to find great deals here and there.

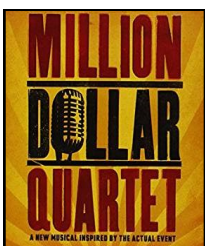
