## Did you know???

You can now send your bills electronically with Bill Pay through our new Digital Banking. Choose from a list of businesses to set up an e-bill, including your KVSB credit card! If the business is not available for e-bill, you can track the paper check or even do a rush delivery for an extra fee.

## New Services for 2020 and beyond:



- 1) MobiMoney - This product allows customers personal control of their debit card. They can track purchase activity in real time via texts to their phone. They can deactivate their card in the event of suspected fraud AND have the ability to activate or deactivate the card as they choose. MobiMoney provides customers with peace of mind using their KVSB debit card.
- 2) Digital Banking project along with a new bill payment platform with Allied bill payment - This project has been moving along this year...implementation is on March 2nd, 2021. These electronic banking platforms will provide KVSB customers with the best internet and mobile banking services we could find in the market.
- 3) DPX (E-pay\$) - KVSB now originates this file. This allows our customers to send, receive, or transfer money in less than 24 hours Monday-Friday if transferred by 2:00 pm CST.
- 4) Contactless debit cards - Our customers now have contactless technology in the debit card they carry.... This is particularly important during this year of Covid.
- 5) March toward "Real Time Transactions" We know this is just around the corner—and we are set up to handle it.
- 6) Bank by phone system - This is a system that many customers still love. If you don't want to use the internet, you can still use your telephone.

If any of these services interest you, be sure and ask one of the crew when you come by the bank!

## Message from the Chairman

Dealing with Covid-19 in 2020 has certainly been a trial—for us all! With all the frustrations, I have to admit that the Kaw Valley crew overcame some huge challenges to make sure we could meet our customers' needs. We learned a lot about leveraging technologies and figured out new ways to deliver needed financial services to you and our communities.

In the early months of the Covid threat, we asked the question—How can we assure our customers that we will be open for business no matter what? We talked about possibilities and decided to send some of the staff to satellite locations. As you know, we have three banking locations (Wamego, St. Marys and Clifton). We decided to add two more satellite "Work" locations to spread our risk. Our thought was, if someone in one of our branches would contract Covid-19, we would be able to send that crew home to convalesce, disinfect the area and bring in a fresh crew that would be able to take care of our customers' financial needs.

One satellite location was the old City Office building in St. Marys. The other location was in the basement of my home. We set up work stations in these locations and figured out how to securely connect those stations to the bank via phone and internet. To limit exposure, we installed walkup windows at each branch and kept them well disinfected. We also installed plexiglass shields in our public areas of the bank for customers that needed to come into the bank for their business. With that set-up and our drive-up facilities, we never missed a beat.

Running a business in the ever-changing 2020 "Covid-19" environment required a huge commitment from management and staff to overcome obstacles and meet the financial needs of the communities we serve. The crew never missed a beat.

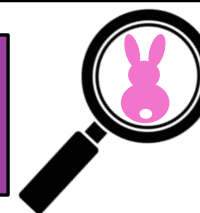


## Money Bag Winners
